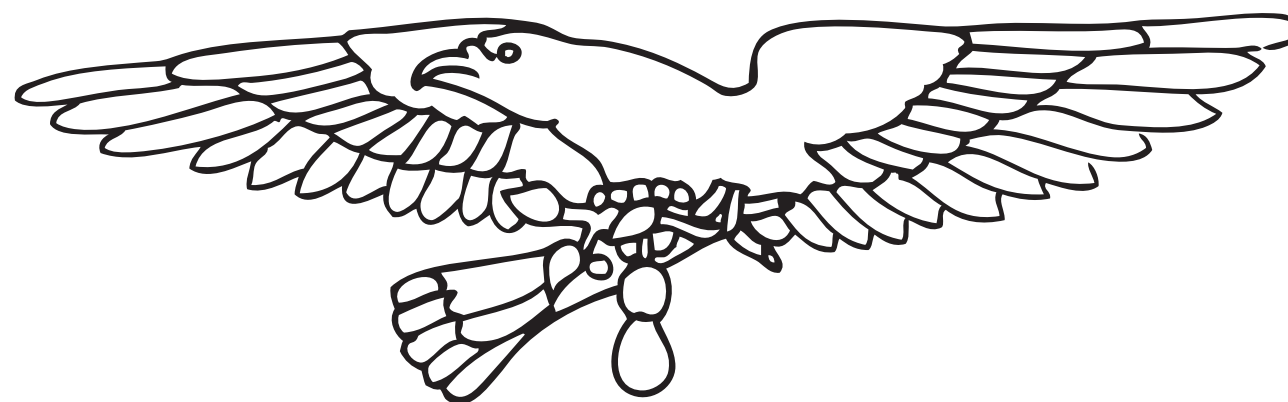
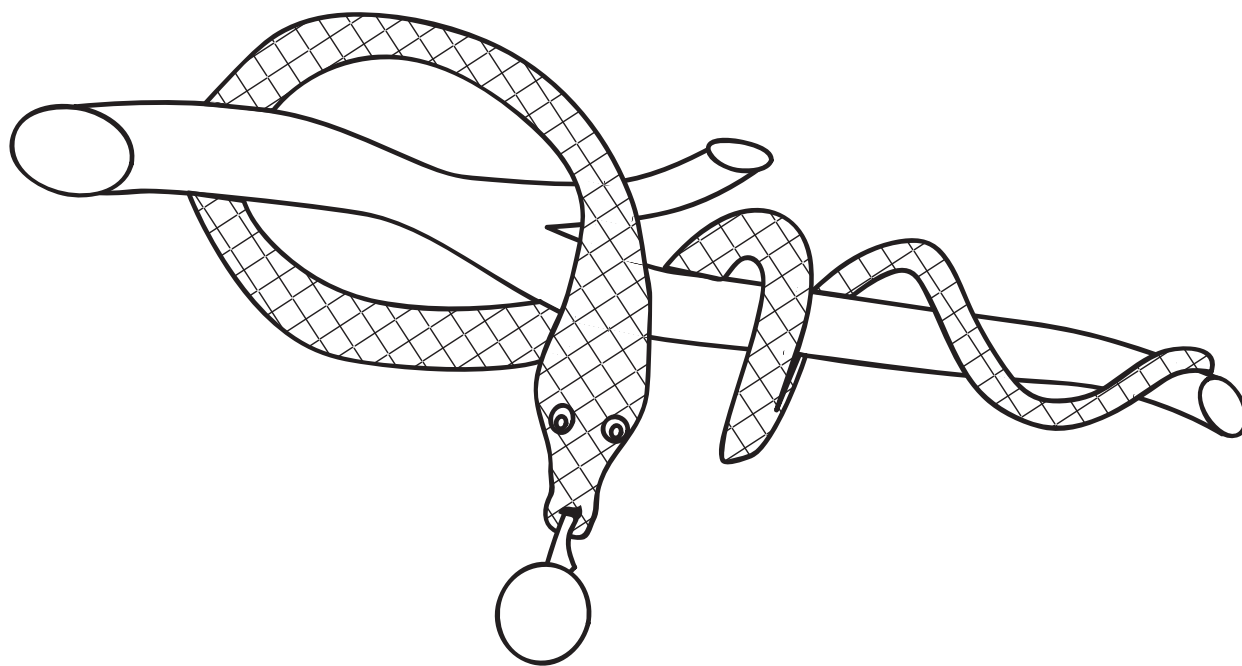
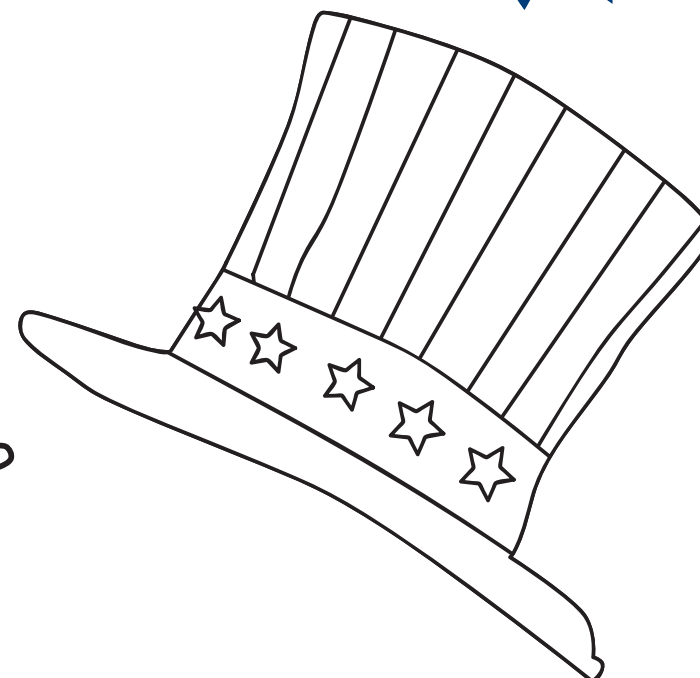
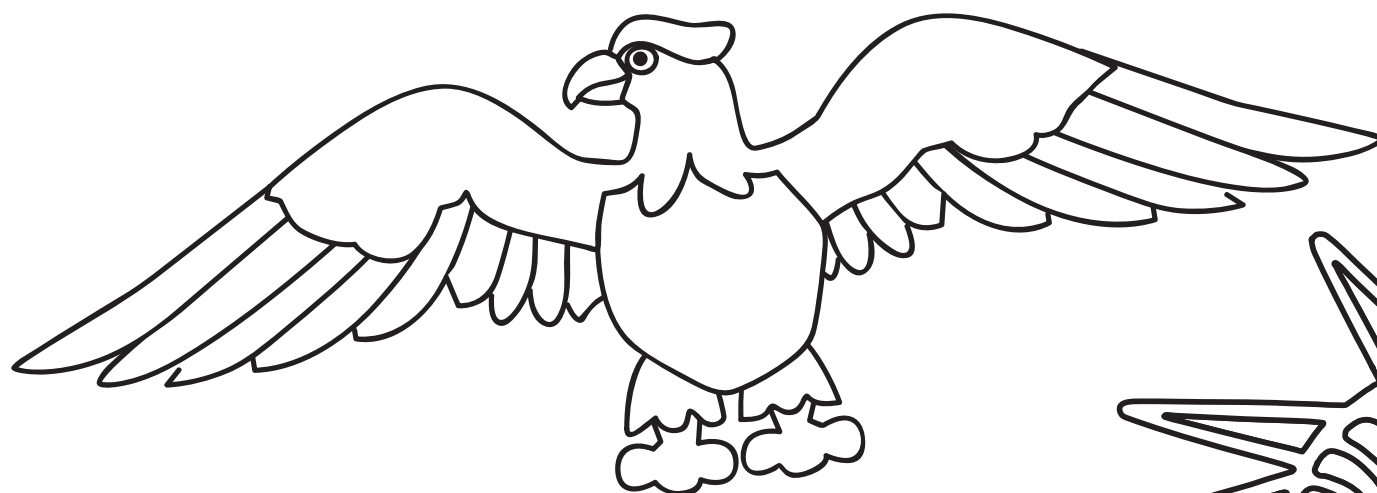




Read My Pins ^{MINI} Tour
